

UNION TOWNSHIP – WARREN COUNTY

BOARD OF TRUSTEES – Regular Meeting – March 1, 2021

CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER: The regular meeting of the Union Township Board of Trustees was called to order by President, Fred Vonderhaar on Monday, 3/1/21 at 6:00 p.m. at the Union Township Municipal Building. The meeting was opened with the Fiscal Officer, Shelley Lamb, taking roll call of the trustees: Fred Vonderhaar, Tony Ledford, and Jamie Allen. Prayer was led by Mr. Ledford. Mr. Vonderhaar led everyone in The Pledge of Allegiance.

CITIZENS IN ATTENDANCE (IF KNOWN): Barbara Aberlin was in attendance. Ms. Aberlin asked about the liquor license policy, as she thought Union Township was a “dry” Township. Mr. Vonderhaar explained to the best of his knowledge, any liquor license had to be applied for to the State of Ohio and then voted on by the appropriate Township precinct. Ms. Aberlin would need to inquire to the proper agencies as to the required procedures.

POLICE SUMMARY: No officers were in attendance.

CHIEF'S REPORT: Chief Napier said he received \$3,093.88 from the State of Ohio for an EMS grant reimbursement. He then stated he was contacted by Tri Health EMS Journal about doing a “spotlight” in one of their future publications on his department. He also spoke to Clary Sign about the new Township sign that should be ready soon. Chief Napier noted the garage doors had all been repaired from recent damage. Mr. Ledford asked Chief Napier about the ice rescue training they did at Oeder’s Lake recently. Chief Napier said all went well, but he wanted to look at some new equipment that would be beneficial in those type situations.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT: Josh Sandlin said they were having issues with the Kenworth. He needs to take it in for service. Mr. Sandlin then reported that Cory Smith has been an employee with Union Township for a year now, and he would like to see him receive a raise, as he thought it was deserved. The Trustees decided to think about this raise request and would re-visit at the next meeting. Mr. Vonderhaar asked Mr. Sandlin to keep an eye on Cox-Smith Road for water/tile issues he has noticed lately. Mr. Sandlin also mentioned he had checked on the tiles at Manistique Lake, and he did not think they were as bad as first thought. Mr. Vonderhaar stated he has been in contact with Dominic Brigano at the Warren County Engineer’s Office about another program for the road repair at Manistique Lakes. They are looking over the options to find the most viable one for the Township.

FISCAL OFFICER’S REPORT: The Fiscal Officer presented the bills to pay, fund status, cemetery deeds, etc. thru March 1, 2021. All were signed and approved by the Board of Trustees.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Ledford stated he had checked into ordering a new truck to replace the F550, but there is no new truck ordering due to COVID until 2022. Mr. Ledford mentioned that Lebanon Ford has a new 750 available at their lot right now. This truck would need a plow, lights, and spreader, but was ready for purchase at around \$97,000.00 if Mr. Sandlin did not think they could wait until 2022. Mr. Ledford said he would get all the info on this truck for further consideration at another meeting.

Mr. Ledford made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar. The motion was carried by all “yeas”.

Mr. Allen made a motion to accept the minutes from the meeting held on 2/16/21, seconded by Mr. Ledford. The motion was carried by all “yeas”.

Mr. Vonderhaar moved for adoption of resolution 030121-01, the Annual Permanent Appropriation Resolution (see attached), seconded by Mr. Ledford. The motion was carried by all “yeas”.

Mr. Vonderhaar said he would be attending the Warren County Health District’s annual meeting on 3/2/21.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Allen to adjourn the meeting at 6:52 p.m. The motion was carried by all “yeas”.
