BOARD OF TRUSTEES - Regular Meeting - January 3, 2022

CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER: The regular meeting of the Union Township Board of Trustees was called to order by President of the Board, Fred Vonderhaar on Monday, 1/3/2022 at 6:00 p.m. at the Union Township Municipal Building. The meeting was opened with the Fiscal Officer, Shelley Lamb, taking roll call of the trustees: Fred Vonderhaar, Jamie Allen, & Chris Koch. Chris Koch was elected Union Township Trustee in the last election, replacing Tony Ledford at the start of 2022. The prayer was led by Chief Napier. Mr. Vonderhaar led everyone in The Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>CITIZENS IN ATTENDANCE (IF KNOWN):</u> Art Perong, David Pittman, & Lee Hamilton were in attendance. Mr. Hamilton presented the Township with a generous gift of a framed map of Union Township from years ago that he came upon at an estate sale in Clinton County.

POLICE SUMMARY: Deputy Pangallo had nothing to report.

CHIEF'S REPORT: Chief Napier presented the Trustees with the quote for the purchase of a 2023 ambulance (see attached). Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion to accept this quote of \$270,232.00, seconded by Mr. Allen. Some of the money needed for this purchase will come from the American Rescue Plan Grant. The remainder will come from the EMS Fund. The motion passed with a "yea" vote from both Mr. Vonderhaar & Mr. Allen. Mr. Koch abstained.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Josh Sandlin stated he was working on a list of roads that need full-depth repair that the Warren County Engineer's Office had requested. The Trustees will also look at the Township roads for this project. Mr. Sandlin again requested all Trustees look at the area for the new road in Deerfield Cemetery to get their opinions on how to proceed.

FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT: The Fiscal Officer presented the bills to pay, fund status, cemetery deeds, etc. thru January 3, 2022. All were signed and approved by Mr. Vonderhaar & Mr. Allen.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: Mr. Allen made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar. The motion was carried by all "yeas".

Mr. Allen made a motion to accept the minutes from the meeting held on 12/20/21, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar. The motion passed with a "yea" vote from both Mr. Vonderhaar & Mr. Allen. Mr. Koch abstained.

Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion to revise the previously adopted CDBG Grant Resolution from December 20, 2021, seconded by Mr. Allen. The motion passed with a "yea" vote from both Mr. Vonderhaar & Mr. Allen. Mr. Koch abstained. The original amount of \$111,075.00 was revised to \$127,800.00 due to current year cost estimate updates by the Warren County Engineer's Office.

Mr. Vonderhaar made motions to adopt the following resolutions - 01032022-01; 01032022-02; 01032022-03; 01032022-04; 01032022-05 (see attached), all were seconded by Mr. Allen. The motions were carried by all "yeas".

Mr. Allen made a motion to appoint Mr. Vonderhaar as President of the Board of Trustees of Union Township for 2022, seconded by Mr. Koch. Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion to appoint Mr. Koch as Vice President of the Board of Trustees for 2022, seconded by Mr. Allen. The motions were carried by all "yeas".

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Allen to adjourn the meeting at 6:29 p.m. The motion was carried by all "yeas". The next regular meeting will be Tuesday, January 18, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.
