

**UNION TOWNSHIP – WARREN COUNTY**

**BOARD OF TRUSTEES – Regular Meeting – April 17, 2023**

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**CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER:** The regular meeting of the Union Township Board of Trustees was called to order by President of the Board, Chris Koch on Monday, 4/17/23 at 6:00 p.m. at the Union Township Municipal Building. The meeting was opened with the Fiscal Officer, Shelley Lamb, taking roll call of the trustees: Fred Vonderhaar, Chris Koch, & Tony Ledford. The prayer was led by Mr. Koch. Mr. Koch led everyone in The Pledge of Allegiance.

**CITIZENS IN ATTENDANCE (IF KNOWN):** David Pittman, Art Perong, & Jim Bowman were in attendance.

**POLICE SUMMARY:** Sergeant Adams & Deputy Pangallo reported the City of South Lebanon would be installing 5 Flock cameras in the area.

**ROAD SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT:** Mr. Sandlin reported there had been some complaints about drivers on Church Street and he was going to speak to the owners of a business in the area about the issue. Mr. Sandlin said there was damage to the side of Lebanon Road. A complaint concerning this issue had also been reported to the Warren County Zoning Department. Mr. Tyler Holden reported he and/or his business was responsible for this damage, and he would take care of the repair. Mr. Koch stated he would follow up with Mr. Holden concerning a timeline for this repair.

**CHIEF’S REPORT:** Chief Napier was not in attendance.

**FISCAL OFFICER’S REPORT:** The Fiscal Officer presented the bills to pay, fund status, cemetery deeds, etc. thru April 17, 2023. All were signed and approved by Mr. Vonderhaar, Mr. Koch, & Mr. Ledford.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion to approve 2 culvert replacements (approximately \$8,000.00) in Manistique Lakes as per the request from Mr. Sandlin, seconded by Mr. Ledford. The motion was carried by all “yeas”. This is a previous passed motion revision from \$5,000 to \$8,000 (4/3/23) due to cost & material corrections.

Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Mr. Ledford. The motion was carried by all “yeas”.

Mr. Ledford made a motion to accept the quote from M. P. Dory Co. in the amount of \$9,650.00 for 250’ of guardrail/posts on Dry Run Road, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar. The motion was carried by all “yeas”.

Mr. Ledford made a motion to accept the minutes from the meeting held on 4/3/23, seconded by Mr. Koch. The motion was carried by all “yeas”.

Mr. Koch said he spoke to the Warren County Prosecutor’s Office about the residence on Dry Run Road concerning zoning violations and was advised they are actively working on this case and will come to a future meeting to update Union Township about the ongoing process.

**ADJOURNMENT:** There being no further business, Mr. Koch made a motion, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar to adjourn the meeting at 6:25 p.m. The motion was carried by all “yeas”. The next regular meeting will be held on Monday, May 1, 2023, at 6:00 p.m.
