

## UNION TOWNSHIP – WARREN COUNTY

### BOARD OF TRUSTEES – Regular Meeting – January 8, 2025

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**CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER:** The regular meeting (re-scheduled from 1/6/25 due to weather) of the Union Township Board of Trustees was called to order by President of the Board, Chris Koch on Wednesday, 1/8/25 at 6:00 p.m. at the Union Township Building. Trustees in attendance: Chris Koch, Fred Vonderhaar & Rhonda Cockerham. The prayer was led by Mr. Vonderhaar. Mrs. Cockerham led everyone in The Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Koch made a motion for Mr. Vonderhaar to be Chairperson of the Board for 2025, seconded by Mrs. Cockerham. Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion for Mrs. Cockerham to be Vice-Chairperson of the Board, seconded by Mr. Koch. Mr. Koch made a motion for Mr. Vonderhaar to be Road Supervisor, seconded by Mrs. Cockerham. Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion for Mr. Koch to be Zoning Representative, seconded by Mrs. Cockerham. All motions were carried by all “yeas”.

**POLICE SUMMARY:** Deputy Fox had nothing to report.

**ROAD SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT:** Mr. Sandlin stated there had been no issues with the recent snow removal.

**CHIEF’S REPORT:** Chief Napier said he would like to hire Brad Allen full-time starting in February. All Trustees agreed with this request. He is going to be looking into the firehouse parking lot water drainage issue. The River Cove Subdivision’s HOA requested use of the meeting room for 3/6/25, which is now scheduled.

**FISCAL OFFICER’S REPORT:** The Fiscal Officer presented the bills to pay, fund status, cemetery deeds, etc. thru January 8, 2025. All were signed and approved by Mr. Koch, Mr. Vonderhaar, & Mrs. Cockerham. She also presented Resolutions 010825-01; 010825-02; 010825-03; 010825-04; 010825-05 (see attached). All resolutions were adopted.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Mr. Koch said he had checked with the Warren County Zoning Department again on the Dry Run property. There were a few items that have been sent over to the Warren County Prosecutor’s Office for review. Mr. Koch had mentioned in the past, the possibility of having “green burials” at the Fellowship Cemetery, and he is going to gather more information for a report at a future meeting. Mr. Koch made a motion to accept the minutes from the meeting held on 12/16/24, seconded by Mrs. Cockerham. The motion was carried by all “yeas”.

Mrs. Cockerham made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar. The motion was carried by all “yeas”.
