

UNION TOWNSHIP – WARREN COUNTY

BOARD OF TRUSTEES – Regular Meeting – February 3, 2025

CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER: The regular meeting of the Union Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Chairperson of the Board, Fred Vonderhaar on Monday, 2/3/25 at 6:00 p.m. at the Union Township Building. Trustees in attendance: Chris Koch, Fred Vonderhaar & Rhonda Cockerham. The prayer was led by Mr. Koch. Mrs. Cockerham led everyone in The Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC SPEAKER(S): Rodney Cockerham has some cemetery deed issues and will make an appointment with the Fiscal Officer to get them cleared up.

POLICE SUMMARY: Sergeant Adams stated there had been several package thefts from porches in the area.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Mr. Sandlin stated a resident questioned why there aren't any "No Parking" signs in a Riverwalk Subdivision cul-de-sac. Mr. Vonderhaar stated after the road work is completed in Riverwalk the "No Parking" signs could go up after checking with the Warren County Prosecutor's Office for approval. Mr. Sandlin mentioned a Deerfield Cemetery five lot deed issue. No deeds/records/payments for these lots (G190 A-B-C-E-F) have been found by Union Township, so ownership belongs to Union Township unless the family can produce their purchase paperwork.

CHIEF'S REPORT: Chief Napier had nothing to report.

FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT: The Fiscal Officer was not in attendance, but left the bills to pay, fund status, cemetery deeds, etc. thru February 3, 2025. All were signed and approved by Mr. Koch, Mr. Vonderhaar, & Mrs. Cockerham.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Koch & Mrs. Cockerham said a resident asked about getting lighted caution signage for the intersection of Shawhan & Stubbs Mill Roads. Mr. Vonderhaar will contact the Warren County Engineer's Office for advice on signage and/or a traffic study for the intersection. Mr. Koch had some reference materials on green burials in an Anderson cemetery. Mr. Koch made a motion to accept the minutes from the meeting held on 1/21/25, seconded by Mrs. Cockerham. The motion was carried by all "yeas".

Mrs. Cockerham made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar. The motion was carried by all "yeas".

Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion to adopt Resolution #02032025-01 Authorizing Contract with the Warren County Engineer's Office for Purchase of Road Salt (see attached), seconded by Mrs. Cockerham. Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion to adopt Resolution #02032025-02 Warren County Drug Task Force 2025 Contribution (see attached), seconded by Mr. Koch. The motions were carried by all "yeas". All Trustees agreed to acknowledge on the Union Township sign for a week, the retirement announcement of three Salem/Morrow firefighters.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Koch to adjourn the meeting at 6:38 p.m. The motion was carried by all "yeas". The next regular meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 18, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.
