

UNION TOWNSHIP – WARREN COUNTY

BOARD OF TRUSTEES – Regular Meeting – February 18, 2025

CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER: The regular meeting of the Union Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Chairperson of the Board, Fred Vonderhaar on Tuesday, 2/18/25 at 6:00 p.m. at the Union Township Building. Trustees in attendance: Chris Koch, Fred Vonderhaar & Rhonda Cockerham. The prayer was led by Mrs. Cockerham. Mr. Koch led everyone in The Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC SPEAKER(S): Ashley Yountz was in attendance as required to qualify for the Warren County Township Association Scholarship.

POLICE SUMMARY: Sergeant Adams stated all deputies would soon be wearing body cams after training. He also mentioned the Warren County Sheriff's Office would now be servicing the Village of Maineville.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Mr. Sandlin reported his department had been busy with rain & snow cleanup. Mr. Vonderhaar asked him to check on the corner of Cox-Smith & Mustang Roads.

CHIEF'S REPORT: Chief Napier stated he had received approval on a new Memorandum of Understanding from Adam Nice in the Warren County Prosecutor's Office for the Warren County Career Center's Fire Science Internship Shadowing Program. Chief Napier presented a quote for a new router from CDW-G in the amount of \$810.72. Mr. Koch made a motion to accept this quote, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar. The motion was carried by all "yeas". Chief Napier asked to send Brad Allen to medic school, which could total \$11,000 upon completion. Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion to allow this school enrollment, seconded by Mrs. Cockerham. The motion was carried by all "yeas". Mr. Koch asked Chief Napier to check into a possible one- or two-year work contract when Union Township pays for this kind of training.

FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT: The Fiscal Officer presented the bills to pay, fund status, cemetery deeds, etc. thru February 18, 2025. All were signed and approved by Mr. Koch, Mr. Vonderhaar, & Mrs. Cockerham.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Koch made a motion to accept the minutes from the meeting held on 2/3/25, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar. The motion was carried by all "yeas".

Mrs. Cockerham made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Mr. Koch. The motion was carried by all "yeas".

Mr. Vonderhaar stated Warren County Engineer Kurt Weber is looking at doing a traffic study for the Stubbs Mill/Shawhan Road intersection. He said the Warren County Zoning Department will be checking on a deck issue in the Riverwalk Subdivision.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, Mr. Vonderhaar made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Cockerham to adjourn the meeting at 6:35 p.m. The motion was carried by all "yeas". The next regular meeting will be held on Monday, March 3, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.
