BOARD OF TRUSTEES – Regular Meeting – May 19, 2025

CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER: The regular meeting of the Union Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Chairperson of the Board, Fred Vonderhaar on Monday, 5/19/25 at 6:00 p.m. at the Union Township Building. Trustees in attendance: Fred Vonderhaar & Rhonda Cockerham. Chris Koch was absent. The prayer was led by Mrs. Cockerham. Mr. Vonderhaar led everyone in The Pledge of Allegiance.

POLICE SUMMARY: Deputy Morgan had nothing to report.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Mr. Sandlin presented a quote for a new John Deere tractor for the Trustees to review and discuss the purchase at a future meeting. Mr. Sandlin said he had put gravel on Harding Street due to the complaints of dirt on the road. Mr. Sandlin reported he would be replacing a pipe on Bunnell Road.

CHIEF'S REPORT: Chief Napier said the Memorial Day Parade preparations were underway. He then stated he had taken a call about a mowing issue on Harvest Lane in Highlands at Heritage Hill Subdivision. Chief Napier will check the status of the lot to make sure it has been mowed. This resident on Harvest Lane also mentioned there is poison hemlock close to his property and asked Chief Napier to see if the Warren County Health Department could be of assistance in the removal of the plant. Chief Napier will contact them for guidance.

FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT: The Fiscal Officer presented the bills to pay, fund status, cemetery deeds, etc. through May 19, 2025. All were signed and approved by Mr. Vonderhaar & Mrs. Cockerham.

NEW BUSINESS: Mrs. Cockerham said there was an email complaint received about a property on Stubbs Mill Road that involved the Warren County Health Department. Mrs. Cockerham made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Mr. Vonderhaar. The motion was carried by all "yeas".

Mr. Vonderhaar mentioned Mr. Joseph Patrick of Westport Drive had been asked to come to the meeting to discuss a discharge pipe issue on his property, but he did not attend.
